After 2 km, you will ski past our beautiful Chalet for the first time, then do 1, 2 or 3 laps (the choice is yours) of our modified 7.5km Race Loop. Distances are 7.5, 13 or 18 kilometres.

The massed start at Ross Lake will be at 1:00pm - make sure to check in and pick up your bib at the lake between noon and 12:50pm. The lap and finish line (and drink station) are right next to Chalet. Once you finish, kick off those skis and come in to socialize and enjoy lunch.
